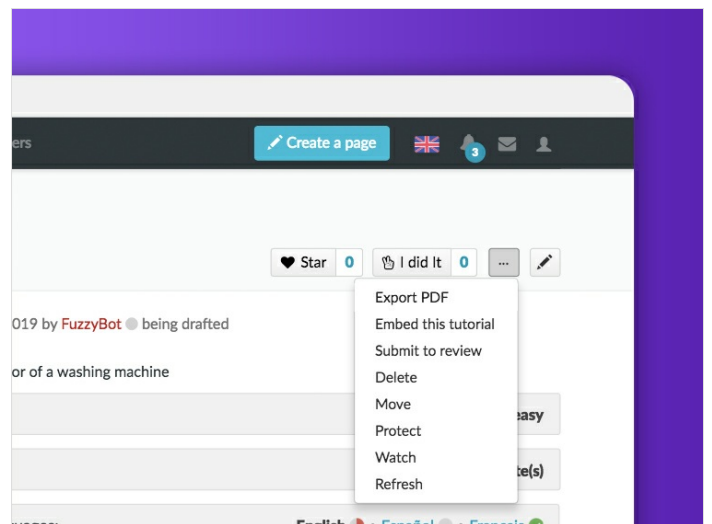

## Step 1 - Accessing the image editing interface

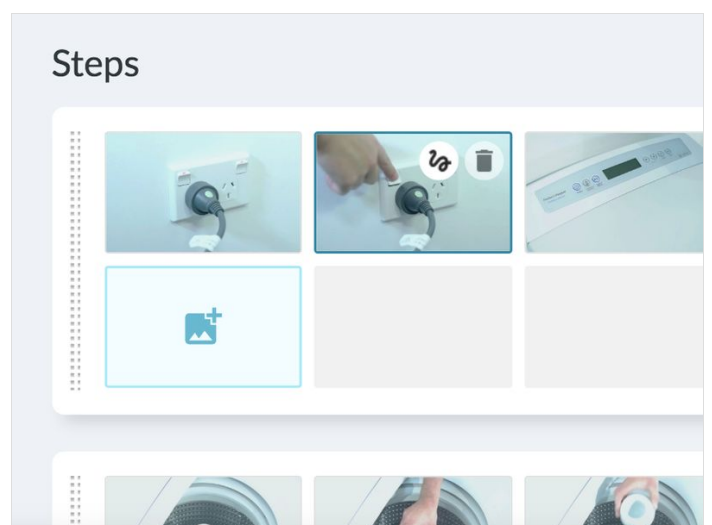
Select the tutorial for which an image needs to be resized.  
In the selected tutorial, click on the right side of the screen on *the pencil icon* to edit the tutorial.  
Click on the image to be modified :  
*2 icons* appear in the upper right corner of the image.  
Select the icon on the left to open the editing interface for images.



## Step 2 - Crop an image

Click on the **crop icon** on the left, to resize the image.  
Click on the thinned area (which delimits the frame of the image)  
and hold down the mouse to direct the area onto the image.  
To *enlarge or reduce the size of the image*, click on the corners and  
adjust the size by holding down the mouse.  
Once the image is resized click on *Crop*.

 You can also change the size of your images using the 1:1, 4:3 and 16:9 formats available in the image editing interface.
